They hide their faces with their umbrella and a book as they have not been given permission to have their photograph taken by a male relative, as is customary. Since the end of the Taliban regime, girls have been given the right to education, yet in rural Afghanistan most girls do not attend school and over 95% of the female population is illiterate.
